7-1-1: **SIGNS AND MARKINGS DEEMED NOTICE OF REGULATION:**
All signs and markings presently or hereafter installed or placed upon any Village street or alley by direction of the Village Board, or by any officer or agent of the state having authority so to do, shall be taken and deemed to be notice to all persons using such streets and alleys of the regulations applicable thereto, and failure to conform to such regulations, as indicated by failure to comply with the directives of such signs and markings, shall be deemed a violation of this Title. The Village Board hereby adopts and ratifies all such signs and markings presently installed or placed upon any Village street or alley as having been installed or placed by its direction. (Ord., 4-88-1, 4-5-1988)

7-1-2: **STOP STREETS:** Stop signs shall be installed at the following locations in the Village:

Corner of CATLIN STREET and LOCUST STREET. (Ord., 9-8-1988)

Northeast corner of ORANGE STREET and PLEASANT STREET.
(Ord. 8-9-8, 9-9-2008)

7-1-3: **ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS:** It shall be unlawful to operate any vehicle on the following streets or alleys, designated hereby as one-way streets or alleys, in any direction other than that so designated by official signs or markings:

EAST CATLIN STREET, from its intersection with North Main Street southbound toward and to its intersection with North Madison Street. (Ord., 4-88-1, 4-5-1988)

7-1-4: **U-TURNS:**

- A. U-Turns Prohibited: U-turns are prohibited within the corporate limits of the Village at the following intersections:

MAIN STREET (marked U.S. Highway 20) and any street of the Village at which an official sign or marking prohibiting the same has been installed or placed. (Ord., 4-88-1, 4-5-1998)

- 7-1-5: **EXCESSIVE ACCELERATION OR NOISE:** It shall be an unlawful to operate any vehicle from a parked, stopped or standing position or from a moving position in such manner as to accelerate said vehicle excessively, or to test the acceleration or speed of said vehicle, or to create unusually loud or unnecessary noise, whether or not the speed attained by said vehicle exceeds any speed limit applicable to the streets and alleys of the Village.

- 7-1-6: **METAL PROJECTIONS ON TIRES PROHIBITED:** No tractor, traction engine, motor truck or other similar vehicle shall be operated across, over or along any public street of the Village if any such vehicle has on the periphery of any of the road wheels any block, stud, flange, cleat, ridge, lug, or any projection of metal or wood which projects radially beyond the tread or traffic surface of the tire. (1979 Code §14-3)

- 7-1-7: **PENALTY:** Violations of Sections 7-1-3, 7-1-4 and 7-1-5 of this Chapter shall, upon conviction therefore, be punishable by fine in accordance with Section 1-4-1 of this Code. (Ord., 4-88-1, 4-5-1988)
