

ORDINANCE NO.

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE NUMBER 7-6-1 OF THE VILLAGE OF OPERATION ALLOWING NEIGHBORHOOD VEHICLES ON ROADWAYS.

WHEREAS, IT IS IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH, ILLINOIS, THAT AN ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED.

WHEREAS, Chapter 7, Operation Allowing Neighborhood Vehicles on Roadways, Section 7-6-1(B): Requirements, reads as follows:

B. Any Neighborhood Vehicle operating on roadways under jurisdiction of the Village of Elizabeth must conform with the requirements of 625 ILCS 5/11-1426.1(e). In addition, only valid licensed drivers 21 years of age or older may operate neighborhood vehicles on roadways under the jurisdiction of the Village, and each Neighborhood Vehicle must be registered yearly with the Village Clerk or Police Department and pay an annual registration fee of \$25.00 and shall be issued a license to be displayed on the back of the Neighborhood Vehicle. Neighborhood Vehicles shall only be operated in daylight hours only.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that the Village of Elizabeth approves an ordinance to add language to Chapter 7, Operation Allowing Neighborhood Vehicles on Roadways, Section 7-6-1(B): Requirements so that it shall read as follows:

B. Any Neighborhood Vehicle operating on roadways under jurisdiction of the Village of Elizabeth must conform with the requirements of 625 ILCS 5/11-1426.1(e). In addition, only a valid driver's license is required to operate neighborhood vehicles on roadways under the jurisdiction of the Village, and each Neighborhood Vehicle must be registered yearly with the Village Clerk or Police Department and pay an annual registration fee of \$25.00 and shall be issued a license to be displayed on the back of the Neighborhood Vehicle. Neighborhood Vehicles shall only be operated in daylight hours only.

WHEREAS, The Village Board intends to approve an ordinance amending the Public Ways and Property Ordinance.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that the Village of Elizabeth approves an ordinance Public Ways and Property.

All other terms and provisions of the original ordinance shall remain the same.
