

ORDINANCE NO. 20180919

ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ILLINOIS VEHICLE CODE AS LOCAL
VIOLATIONS IN THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Elizabeth desires to enforce certain traffic matters as local ordinance violations as specified in Ordinance 7-7-1 Administrating Ticketing: and

WHEREAS, the Village of Elizabeth desires to adopt the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code as its Village Code.

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the Village of Elizabeth, Jo Daviess County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: Incorporation of Recitals: The recitals set forth above are incorporated as if set forth herein as this Section 1.

The Village of Elizabeth hereby adopts the Illinois Vehicle Code as set forth herein:

Section 1: Illinois Vehicle Code Adopted

The Village adopts the following Chapters of 625 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/1 et seq., by reference, as amended from time to time, to be the same and as a part of the Ordinance 7-1-1 of the Village Code:

1. Chapter 3, Certificates of Title and Registration of Vehicles;
2. Chapter 6, Illinois Driver Licensing Law;
3. Chapter 7, Illinois Safety Responsibility Law;
4. Chapter 11, Rules of the Road;
5. Chapter 12, Equipment of Vehicles; and
6. Chapter 15, Size, Weight, Load and Permits.

Section 2: Violations: The penalty for each violation shall be \$75.00.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provisions of this chapter may be issued a Administrative Ticket as specified in Ordinance 7-7-1, excluding violations of offenses as specified in Supreme Court rule 551 of the Illinois Revised Statutes.
