

AN ORDINANCE FOR HEAVY EQUIPMENT ON SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH HAS DECIDED IT IS IN THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH'S BEST INTEREST TO CREATE LICENSING STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR HEAVY EQUIPMENT ON SIDEWALKS.

WHEREAS, IT IS IN THE MATTER OF THE PUBLIC WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH, ILLINOIS, THAT AN ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED TO PROVIDE LEGAL STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS ENABLING RESIDENTS FOR HEAVY EQUIPMENT ON SIDEWALKS.

WHEREAS, IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CITIZENS OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH THAT HEAVY EQUIPMENT IS NOT PERMITTED ON THE SIDEWALKS TO PREVENT ANY DAMAGES TO THE VILLAGE SIDEWALKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH, ILLINOIS HEREBY DECLARES THAT PLACING OR DRIVING OF HEAVY EQUIPMENT ON VILLAGE SIDEWALKS SHALL BE PROHIBITED AS FOLLOWS:

No motor vehicles will be allowed to be driven or parked on Village sidewalks.

Any other vehicle shall have a three thousand (3,000) pound weight limit so that any vehicle in excess of three thousand (3,000) pound will prohibited from being operated or parked on the sidewalks of the Village of Elizabeth.

WHEREAS, The Village Board intends to approve an ordinance which provides legal standards and requirements for Heavy Equipment on Sidewalks.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that the Village of Elizabeth approves an Ordinance for Heavy Equipment on Sidewalks.

All other terms and provisions of the original ordinance shall remain the same.


